- Fun Fair 2023 Disbursement of funds (INITIAL proposal)
 - o **Fun Fair 2023 total Profit \$8,710**
 - o \$2000 to go towards Chromebook.
 - o \$3000 to go towards playground fund/sports equipment
 - o \$1500 to go towards kinder play area fund/carpets
 - o \$2200 to go towards classroom purchases \$5 per student
 - o Jodie provided this update
 - o Motion to approve – Katie, second Kaleigh

- Continued to discuss School Council Funds for Purchases
 - o Individual classroom lists - \$5 PER STUDENT can come from there
 - o Division/Floor Wish – some being covered out of fun fair money
- School wish list– Scientist in the School , laminator, updated AV equipment , school shirts and jerseys, more painting outside for grades 1-3
 - o Anita thinks the AV would be greatest and most all around need at 4K
- Jodie asked about Mulch – a test is done when the playground re-opens (need to ensure enough is set aside for this)
- Revision is proposed for the disbursement of council and fun fair funds purchase:
 - o Purchase science in the school \$265/ class (17 classes) with an ask of \$5 per student from parents so some money can be re-couped. School council to subsidize anyone unable to pay the fee.
 - o AV projector around 4K
 - o \$5 per student for classroom needs
 - o Chrome books @ 2K
 - o Understanding that the playground funds will have to be top priority in topping up after the 2024 funfair or the next fundraiser
 - o Vote: Jodie and Heather approved
